Report from Village Clerk, Stephanie Gardner:

- -The number of voter's in the Village of Hodgkins for the Tuesday, November 5, 2024 Election had not been reported online yet.
- -November 12, 2024 is the first day for Candidates to submit petitions for the April 1, 2025 Consolidated election.

Report from Village Attorney, John O'Connell:

Mr. O'Connell reported he and Mr. Rogers were on a Zoom Meeting with the Representatives of the Tollway System. The Southern end of the Tollway renovation project is almost completed. There is vacant property adjacent to the tollway on Santa Fe Drive on the East Side of the street. That was thought to originally be a retention pond. Burlington Northern Santa Fe has interest in the site, which is different from initial. Retention would be needed for this site, and they are looking at the 6 acres across from UPS, adjacent to the 75th Restaurant Project. This is the most valuable property. There was discussion for underground retention also for the property. The Village asked for the Tollway to keep us informed on what this area will be used for.

- -The 6-acre parcel is unincorporated and the Village Surrounds the property on 3 different sides, which meets the requirements for annexation set by the Tollway system. The Village does not want the 6-acres to be for retention.
- -The 75th Street project is moving along.

Report from Village Attorney, Pat Rogers:

Report from Village Comptroller, Melody Salerno:

Mrs. Salerno reported the Board generously approved an increase in all rebates for residents. The garbage rebates for Mobile Home residents and renters start on Wednesday, November 13th and runs through December 13th. The residential rebates are \$221,571.00. The Mobile Home Park Residents rebate are \$180,970.00. The Renters rebate are \$2760.00. Total rebates given are \$401,301.05.

Report from Superintendent, Jody Kovel

Mr. Kovel reported Christmas Decorations are being installed to get ready for Holiday Happenings.

- -The rough in plumbing has been finished for the Public Works Building. The concrete has been poured and the FBi will finish the outside. Work is progressing.
- -Leave pick up continues.
- -2 cargo container boxes have been purchased to hold the Christmas Decorations.

Report from Building Commissioner, Matt Struve:

Mr. Struve reported Duckees has submitted plans for Phase II. BNF has returned the review and they were in compliance except for the Electrical Portion. They will have to address the issues found by BNF. The project is moving forward.

- -2 homes in Valley Oaks will be removed. There is a new manager named Phil. He has been active in the park and addressing issues.
- -1 home will be removed in Parkview.
- -Presale inspections continue.
- -There are new homes being built in town and they are all moving along.

Report from Village Engineer, Thomas Brandstedt:

Mr. Brandstedt reported request proposals for garbage and recycling are due Friday, November 15, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. He and Mr. Rogers will review the proposals and make a recommendation to the Board.

- -The front door glass at First Student Bus Company was replaced. It will be reviewed
- -East Avenue sewer lining is being completed by MWRD. The work will be done at night

Report from Chief of Police, Joseph Klotz:

Chief Klotz reported The Police Department is a collection spot for Toys for Tots. Please bring your new toys prior to December 1st.

Mrs. Moxley reported The Annual Budget Meeting will be in Monday, December 2, 2024 at 5:00 pm.

Public Works Committee, Chairman, Tim Kovel

Mr. Kovel reported on Wednesday there was a box truck that hit a sign, causing it to be sticking out into traffic. This would normally be an IDOT project that would have taken days to fix, but Public works came and fixed the sign within a matter of minutes to prevent an accident.

-On Army Core of Engineering property at the bottom of Leon Cook Drive there were dead trees limbs falling onto the road. This was a hazard to commuters and pedestrians so Public Works trimmed the trees so they were no longer a hazard.
